Council also recognizes they have offered a group of non tax paying businessmen from outside the municipality a much better contract than was offered to a local taxpaying resident to operate a Jr 'A' hockey team business in the Sportsplex. Given the Voodoo have "refused" to sign the existing contract and council has voted to "reconsider" the Voodoo contract, By-law 2014-20, Council agrees that all future negotiations with the Voodoo will be referred to the recreation committee with ALL known information and past conflicting resolutions, agreements and letters of understanding fully disclosed to the recreation committee and that future negotiations happen in open session as in the past. Council recognizes the recreation committee was an integral part in past successful negotiations and is familiar with the process.
