Nomination for Municipal Representative Replacement on Source Protection Committee

The Source Protection Committee (SPC) is a local multi-stakeholder committee responsible for developing the Source Protection Plan for the protection of municipal drinking water sources in Callander, Mattawa, North Bay, Powassan, and South River. Membership on the SPC is evenly allocated between municipal, economic and public-at-large sectors. The Clean Water Act's O.Reg. 288/07 allots a nine member committee (plus the chair and a First Nations representative) for the North Bay-Mattawa Source Protection Area.


The SPC has a vacancy for a municipal representative as a result of the death of Mayor Hector Lavigne of Callander. Mayor Lavigne had been a valued member of the Source Protection Committee since January 2018. Two current members represent the municipal sector with terms expiring August 2023: Beverley Hillier, Manager of Planning and Building Services for the City of North Bay; and Randy McLaren, Mayor of Bonfield.

Municipalities are invited to submit nominations for the vacant Source Protection Committee position. The deadline for submitting your nomination to the Source Protection Authority is Monday, September 14, 2020 and must include an Application completed by the nominee, together with their resume and a letter from the municipality acknowledging its support for the applicant.

Municipalities are encouraged to collaborate on submitting a nomination by way of a letter of support for a particular individual. In the event that multiple names are submitted for the one vacancy, a selection committee composed of Source Protection Authority (SPA) members will interview candidates and make recommendations to the SPA which is responsible for the appointment of SPC members.

In selecting nominees for municipal representation, the fifteen SP Area municipalities should take into consideration the scope of the project, the nominee's qualifications, and the current priorities for the SPC outlined in the Committee Role and Member Responsibilities document attached. The Committee requires a range of expertise.

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Members are asked to make a five-year commitment to serve on the SPC. SPC members receive a \$200/day per diem. For additional information on the Source Protection Plan and the Source Protection Program visit www.actforcleanwater.ca.

#### **Background**

The SPC has been responsible for the creation of the Source Protection (SP) Plan, which was approved in March 2015. Municipalities have already implemented the policies for which they are responsible. However, longer term efforts are required with respect to research, monitoring and education related to blue-green algae in Callander Bay. This involves the municipalities of Callander, Chisholm, East Ferris, North Bay, and Powassan.

During the remainder of 2020, the SPC will assess the appropriateness of the current SP Plan with respect to meeting its objectives to protect sources of municipal drinking water from contamination and/or depletion. To complete this task, the SPC will consider updates to the technical information in the Assessment Report and will review the policies in the Source Protection Plan. The resulting work to amend the current Source Protection Plan will be circulated to municipalities and a public consultation period will be held. The proposed updated Source Protection Plan will then be submitted to the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks for approval.

#### One position available on Source Protection Committee

(North Bay, August 10, 2020) There is one vacancy for a municipal sector representative on the North Bay-Mattawa Drinking Water Source Protection Committee (SPC), a local multi-stakeholder committee responsible for reducing risks to local municipal drinking water sources in Callander, Mattawa, North Bay, Powassan, and South River.

To be considered for the SPC, an applicant must reside in, own or rent land in, be employed in, operate a business in, or be employed by a municipality located in the North Bay-Mattawa Source Protection Area. A selection committee composed of Source Protection Authority (SPA) members will interview candidates and make recommendations to the SPA which is responsible for the appointment of SPC members.

Membership on the SPC is evenly allocated between municipal, economic and general public sectors. There is an additional seat on the 10-member committee for a Nipissing First Nations representative. Members are asked to make a five-year commitment to serve on the SPC. SPC members receive a \$200/day per diem.

Source Protection Committee members include Maurice Schlosser, George Stivrins, Lucy Emmott, Peter Murray, John MacLachlan, Bev Hillier, Andrea Labelle, and Randy McLaren. Wayne Belter is Chair, as appointed by the Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks. The Nipissing First Nations position on the committee is vacant. The current municipal opening is a result of the death of Mayor Hector Lavigne of Callander in early January 2020. Mayor Lavigne had served as a valued member of the Source Protection Committee since January 2018.

Anyone interested in applying to be considered for appointment as a municipal representative must contact the Clerk of a municipality located within the North Bay-Mattawa Source Protection Area and submit a completed application to the Municipality. Municipalities must submit their selections for consideration to the North Bay-Mattawa Source Protection Authority by Monday, September 14, 2020. A letter from the municipality acknowledging its support for the applicant is also required.

This funding opportunity is a one-time fund to support the non-profit sector recover and rebuild from the impacts emerging from COVID-19.

Applicants can request between \$5,000 - \$150,000 on a project that can be completed in 1 year. There are two intact dates – September 2<sup>nd</sup> and December 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2020.

Following are the types of things that may be funded:

- Organizational training and coaching, strategic planning and implementation, research and development, mental and physical health and wellbeing support.
- Development of fundraising plans, fundraising resources.
- Identification of new health and safety processes and required personal protection equipment, technology supports, staffing and volunteer recruitment and training.
- Procurement of equipment or renovation of spaces to meet the new needs of the organization (changing technology health and safety and service delivery options)
- Peer Learning, professional development, knowledge sharing, etc.

The Library has expressed an interest in partnering with us on an application for the following:

- Funding to cover lifelab cost (heating and wages)
- A Zoom subscription
- Costs for craft kits which are being used for Saturday Series programming
- Funds to cover the cost of a free beginner's yoga session (classes need to be smaller so good to have a variety of programming options)
- New IPad loaded with Zoom app these could be leant to seniors and families to permit them to connect with others.

The total cost for these would be around \$5000.

Is Council interested in putting in an application for the 250 Clark Community Hub programming or something else? If so, what should we apply for? And, can the library's wish list be included within our application?

I would like direction as soon as possible – and could submit an application for the Dec. 2 intake.

Please note that this is the funding that mentioned local Legions as being potential applicants. The focus however is on providing new processes, safety equipment, etc. to meet the challenges that COVID-19 has brought forth. I'm not sure what would fall under this re: the Legion?

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Powassan deems it advisable to amend By-Law 2003-38, as amended;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Powassan enacts as follows:

- 1. Schedule 'C', to Zoning By-law No. 2003-38 as amended, is further amended by zoning lands located in Part of Lot 25, Concession 2, (Himsworth), Plan 79, Blks G & H, RP 42R9616, Parts 1 to 5 and Pcl 8523 N/S, Municipality of Powassan from the Highway Commercial (CH) Zone to the Highway Commercial Exception (CH-3) Zone as shown on Schedule A-1 attached hereto.
- 2. And Further, Section 4.5.4 of Zoning By-law 2003-38 as amended, is further amended by adding the following new sub-section after Section 4.5.4.2:

#### 4.5.4.3 Highway Commercial Exception (CH-3) Zone

Notwithstanding Section 4.5.1 of Zoning By-law 2003-38 as amended, on lands located in Part of Lot 25, Concession 2, (Himsworth), Plan 79, Blks G & H, RP 42R9616, Parts 1 to 5 and Pcl 8523 N/S, and located in the CH-3 Zone, all of the uses permitted in the Highway Commercial (HC) Zone as well as the following additional uses shall also be permitted:

a) A detached dwelling;

b) The outside storage and maintenance of heavy equipment, transport trucks and trailers, provided all equipment is in working order and/or holds a current license to travel on public highways.

Furthermore, in the CH-3 Zone the following regulation shall apply:

Minimum Lot Area: 1.8 acres Minimum Front Yard: 35 feet





Schedule 'A', to Zoning By-law No. 2003-38 as amended, is further amended by zoning lands located in Concession 5, Part Lot 24, Pcl 2214 (Himsworth) (140 Hummel Line), in the Municipality of Powassan. from the "Rural (Ru)" Zone to a "Rural Exception (RU-15)" Zone, as shown on Schedule A-1 attached hereto and forming part of this By-law.
- 2. Notwithstanding Sections 3.5 and 4.4.1, no more than two dwelling are permitted on lands located in Ru-15 Zone.
- 3. This By-law shall come into effect upon the date of passage hereof, subject to the provisions of Section 34 (30) and (31) of the Planning Act (Ontario).





Being a by-law to amend by-law 2015-31, to govern the proceedings of Council and its committees

WHEREAS Bill 197 the Covid-19 Economic Recovery Act, which received Royal Assent on July 21, 2020, amended various sections of the Municipal Act with respect to Electronic Participation in meetings;

AND WHEREAS the Municipal Act in Section 238 (3.1) now states that the procedure by-law may provide that members of Council, of a local board or of a committee of either of them, can participate electronically in a meeting to the extent and in the manner set out by the by-law;

WHEREAS the Municipal Act in Section 238 (3.3) states that the applicable procedure by-law may provide that, a member of a council, or local board of a committee of either of them who is participating electronically in a meeting may be counted in determining whether or not a quorum of members is present at any point in time; and that a member of a council, of a local board of a committee of either of them can participate electronically in a meeting that is open or closed to the public; and

Now therefore the Council of the Municipality of Powassan hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That Section 1 be amended to add:
- 1.11 b) "Electronic Meeting" means a Meeting where any Member is not physically present but participates via electronic means of communication.
- 2. That Section 5 be amended to add:
- 5.6 Electronic Participation may be allowed for a member of Council, or a local board or of a committee or either of them in accordance with Section 238 (3.1) of the Municipal Act. Members participating electronically may count towards determining whether a quorum of members is present and may participate in a meeting which is open or closed to the public.
- 5.7 Members must notify the Clerk prior to the meeting of their intent to participate electronically, and to confirm the use of approved technology.
- 5.8 Members of the public wishing to attend a meeting held in whole or in part electronically must confirm their intent to attend by 12:00 pm the day prior with the office of the Clerk at which time the Clerk will determine the method of attendance.

THAT all other provisions of By-Law No 2015-31 shall remain in effect.
