AND BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Municipality of Powassan communicates this resolution to the Premier, with copies to the Minister of Finance, the Minister of Energy, area MPPs, and the Association of Municipalities of Ontario (AMO), and Federation of Northern Ontario Municipalities (FONOM).
