- To give municipalities adequate, stable and long-term funding resources to invest in greenhouse gas reduction initiatives in our communities such as public transit and active transportation, public and private building energy efficiency; water conservation, planning development and other programs;
- To recognize municipal projects that reduce greenhouse gases for offset credits in Cap and Trade programs;
- To provide dedicated funding for climate change adaption to help municipalities provide resilient infrastructure to keep our economies and communities functioning and productive;
- To provide tools to help facilitate and transfer knowledge regarding greenhouse gas reduction and climate adaptation projects

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Corporation of the Municipality of Powassan supports the collaboration of AMO and UQM to positively affect Climate Change; and
