

THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWASSAN

BY-LAW NO. 2006-20

Being a By-Law to amend By-Law No 96-10 to erect stop signs.

WHEREAS Section 137 of the Highway Traffic Act R.S.O. Chapter H.8, confers upon the councils of all municipalities the power to enact by-laws for regulating traffic on highways subject to the Highway Traffic Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 314(7) of the Municipal Act confers upon councils of all municipalities the power to enact by-laws to provide for placing, regulating and maintaining upon the public highways traffic signs for the purpose of guiding and directing traffic;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Powassan deems it desirable to guide and direct traffic by the erection of stop signs at intersections in the Municipality of Powassan.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Powassan enacts as follows;

1. That the intersection of Morrison and McEachern is designated as an intersection where a stop sign shall be erected to regulate the flow of traffic by way of a four way stop.
2. That the penalties provided in Section 214 of the Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against this by-law.
3. That each designation made by Section 1 shall not become effective until stop signs and yield signs have been erected in accordance with the Regulations of the Highway Traffic Act.
4. That By-law 2004-22 be repealed.

READ A FIRST time and considered read a SECOND and THIRD time and passed as such in open Council this 6th day of June 2006.
