

**THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWASSAN**

**BY-LAW NO. 2013-26**

Being a by-law to authorize an agreement between the Corporation of the Municipality of Powassan and the Ontario Clean Water Agency for the provision of operation and maintenance services of the water and wastewater facilities.

WHEREAS the Corporation of the Municipality of Powassan is the owner of water and wastewater facilities; and

WHEREAS the Municipal Water and Sewage Transfer Act 1997 allows the owner to enter into an agreement with respect to the transfer of operation and maintenance services for water and wastewater facilities; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Powassan is desirous of entering into an agreement with the Ontario Clean Water Agency:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF POWASSAN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That the Mayor and Clerk-Treasurer be authorized to execute the agreement, attached as Appendix "A" and forming part of this by-law.
2. That this By-law be effective retroactive January 1, 2013.
