BY-LAW NO. 2017-10

Being a by-law to set tax ratios for municipal purposes for the year 2017

WHEREAS it is necessary for the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Powassan pursuant to the Municipal Act, 2001, (S.O. 2001, c. 25) section 308, to establish the tax ratios for 2017 for the Corporation of the Municipality of Powassan;

AND WHEREAS the tax ratios determine the relative amount of taxation to be borne by each property class;

AND WHEREAS the property classes have been prescribed by the Minister of Finance under the Assessment Act R.S.O. 1990 ch 31, as amended and regulations thereto.

AND WHEREAS Regulation 385/98 allows the municipality to adopt Revenue Neutral Ratios as the new Transition Ratios for 2017;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Municipality of Powassan hereby enact as follows:
