The Corporation of the Municipality of Powassan

By-Law No. 2020-09

Being a By-Law to Confirm Delegated Authorities During a Provincially Declared Emergency (Human Emergency or Pandemic)

WHEREAS Section 23.1 to 23.5 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c. 25, as amended, authorizes a municipality to delegate its powers and duties under this or any other Act to a person or body subject to restrictions under the Act;

AND WHEREAS Section 23.3 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, c. 25 restricts Council from delegating powers and duties:

- 1. The power to appoint or remove from office an officer of the municipality whose appointment is required by this Act.
- 2. The power to pass by-laws under Parts VIII, IX and X.
- 3. The power to incorporate corporations in accordance with Section 203.
- 4. The power to adopt an official plan or an amendment to an official plan under the *Planning Act*.
- 5. The power to pass a zoning by-law under the Planning Act.
- 6. The power to pass a by-law under subsections 108(1) and (2), and 110 (3), (6) and (7).
- 7. The power to adopt a community improvement plan under section 28 of the *Planning Act*.
- 8. The power to adopt or amend the budget of the municipality.
- 9. Any other power or duty that may be prescribed.

AND WHEREAS Council deems it expedient to delegate authority to the Chief Administrative Officer/Clerk-Treasurer or their designate to take action, where necessary, on certain acts during a Provincially declared emergency.

Now Therefore, The Council of The Corporation of the Municipality of Powassan Hereby enacts as follows:

1. That the Chief Administrative Officer/Clerk-Treasurer, or their delegate, be delegated the authority to approve contracts for projects approved by the Budget; and that the Chief Administrative Officer/Clerk-Treasurer be authorized to sign approved contracts.

2. That Council delegates authority to the Chief Administrative Officer/Clerk-Treasurer, or their delegate, of The Corporation of the Municipality of Powassan to take action, where necessary, during a Provincially declared emergency.

Such action may include:

- (a) Waiving fees and penalties for Billings;
- (b) Authority to determine and/or alter the Billing due dates and methods of payment; and
- (c) Authorized spending limit for the Chief Administrative Officer/Clerk-Treasurer shall be set for \$150,000.00 per sale.
- 3. That the Chief Administrative Officer will report to Council on any actions taken during a Provincially declared emergency.
- 4. That this By-Law shall be in effect during a Provincially declared emergency.
- 5. That this By-Law shall come into force and effect upon its final passage.
- 6. That this By-Law may be cited as the "Emergency Delegation of Powers By-Law".
- 7. That the Mayor and Clerk be and hereby authorized to execute this By-Law on behalf of the Corporation and to fix the corporate seal thereto.
