BY-LAW NO. 2011-28

Being a By-Law to appoint a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer

WHEREAS Section (8)1 of the Municipal Act, 2001 enables municipalities to govern their affairs as they consider appropriate and to enhance their ability to respond to municipal issues; and

WHEREAS Section 15 (1) of the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.15, states that a municipal council may appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality; and

WHEREAS Section 15 (2) of the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.15, states that municipal law enforcement officers are peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws.


NOW THEREFORE be it resolved that the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of Powassan enacts as follows:

1. That Laurie Hoyt be appointed as Municipal Law Enforcement Officer effective upon adoption.
2. That the Municipal Law Enforcement Officer shall be responsible for the enforcement of Chapter P.33 of the Provincial Offences Act R.S.O. 1990 as amended.
3. That the MLEO be appointed to serve as the Property Standards Officer who shall be responsible for the administration and enforcement of the Property Standards By-law.
4. That By-law 2009-47 be repealed.


Read a first time in open Council on June 21, 2011.
