- 4. That By-law 2011-13 be repealed.

BY-LAW no. 2011-41 Schedule "A" CEMC Terms of Employment

- 1. Hours of work will not exceed 300 hours per year, excluding declared emergencies.
- 2. Rate of Pay will be as per Band 5 of the Pay Grid- CEMC-Step 5.
- 3. The CEMC shall work flexible hours due to nature of position which could occur any time during the day, evening or week.
- 4. The role of the position is to ensure the Municipality meets the requirements of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act and regulations issued under the Act by the Province of Ontario.
- 5. The position shall guide, as per the Municipal Emergency Plan, the Municipality in the event of an emergency.
